MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING, is entered into this _____th day of _____, 2004, by and between the State of Illinois, acting through the Illinois Department of Public Health and hereinafter called the "State" and the Village of Oak Park Department of Public Health.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the State has the duty to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Public Health is responsible for protecting the state's 12.4 million residents, as well as countless visitors, through the prevention and control of disease and injury; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Park Department of Public Health is a certified Health Department which provides HIV outreach, health education and anonymous, confidential testing to individuals at risk for HIV and has a collaborative arrangement with the PCC Community Wellness Center to serve as a site for HIV testing as well as to assist in providing additional screening for sexually transmitted disease and performs HIV/AIDS surveillance as required by the Illinois Department of Public Health and case management for person with HIV and AIDS; and

WHEREAS, the parties shall enter into a grant or award agreement, to be effective for fiscal year 2005 and subject to compliance with all applicable State law and necessary certifications, on the basis of the following terms, among others:

The State will agree:

- 1. To provide \$50,000 to the Village of Oak Park Department of Public Health for HIV/AIDS testing and screening;

The Village of Oak Park Department of Public Health will agree:

- 2. To meet all duties and obligations imposed by state law respecting nonfederal-aid projects;
- 3. To promptly pay all persons and entities engaged on projects undertaken pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding;
- 4. To assume the responsibility for the initiatives of the Village of Oak Park Department of Public Health's HIV/AIDS screening and testing programs; and

The parties will mutually agree:


- 5. That, with respect to the State funding, program initiation will be the responsibility of the Village of Oak Park Department of Public Health and is to be coordinated with the State.
